Prayer Walking - This is right up your street!

Prayer walking is just what it sounds like — simply walking and talking to God. Prayer walkers don't make a big thing about what they're doing. In fact, it is praying on scene without making one. Prayer walking opens up doors of opportunity to see and hear the prompting's of the Holy Spirit. Encountering your community enlarges your heart for the people and enlarges your heart for mission and evangelism. If we don't walk our streets and pray for our neighbours then who will? Our streets are walked mostly by people who live in spiritual darkness how wonderful to walk these same streets and pray in light and life.

As we prayer walk we are able at the prompting's of the Holy Spirit to pray into all kinds of situations — marriages, families, parents, children, divorce and separation, violence and abuse, young people, schools and education, employment, drug and alcohol abuse, crime and law and order, homelessness, single parent families, stress, poverty, loneliness, the elderly, heath to name but a few — no shortage of powerful prayer opportunities — yes you can pray for all these in churches and from your own home but how more real it is to see these situations face to face with real people.

As you prayer walk your street sometime people will ask you what you are doing and in telling them, opens up opportunity for praying with people and being able to be the hands and feet and tongue of Jesus to them.

Lighthouses of Prayer

What is a Lighthouse? A Lighthouse is a person, family or small group committed to pray for, care for and share Christ with family members, friends, classmates, coworkers and neighbours, especially those who do not know Him. Praying, caring, sharing Christians impact the lives of those in their circle of influence. Prayer moves God's hand in their lives (James 5:16). Caring demonstrates God's love in practical ways (Romans 12:21). Sharing exposes them to the power of the Gospel (Romans 1:16).

Who can be a lighthouse? Every believer has what it takes to be a Lighthouse. Christ who is the Light of the world dwells in each of us. Lighting our world is simply a matter of letting Christ shine through us. As it is the nature of a light bulb to give light, so it's the nature of a Christian to shine. Every true Christian, having access to God's throne through Jesus Christ, can pray. Every believer, having been touched by God's loving care, can care. Every child of God, having been touched by God's grace, can share the good news.

How should I pray? Think of the word **BLESS** to remember five important ways to pray for your neighbours:

- **B** Body health, protection, strength
- L Labour work, income, security
- **E** Emotional joy, peace, comfort, inner quiet
- S Social love, marriage, family, friends
- S Spiritual salvation, faith, grace

Pray especially for God to free those who are in bondage to the evil one giving them light to see, ears to hear, open minds and responsive hearts. "2Corinthians Ch 4v4"

Every verse is a mandate for a changed life. God has used it to bring healing and wholeness and hope into our own lives so from our experience of the goodness of God we are able then to pray that same blessing into the lives of those we see as we walk. The Lord's Prayer is another scripture we can use. Remember the Word of God is powerful.... Keep using it.
